SERMON: The Advantages of Seeking God Early

Hope: Now when the Sabbath was past, Mary Magdalene, Mary the mother of James, and Salome bought spices that they might come and anoint Him. Very early in the morning, on the first day of the week, they came to the tomb when the sun had risen.

And entering the tomb, they saw a young man clothed in a long white robe sitting on the right side; and they were alarmed.

But he said to them, "Do not be alarmed. You seek Jesus of Nazareth, who was crucified. He is risen! He is not here.

Mark 16:1-6

TRUE FELLOWSHIP: Very early in the morning, while it was still dark, Jesus got up, left the house and went off to a solitary place, where he prayed. At daybreak Jesus went out to a solitary place.

Mark 1:35; Luke 4:42

GODLY CHILDREN: Remember, also, your Creator in the days of your youth, before the evil days come and the years draw near when you will say, "I have no delight in them".

Romans 12:1

You shall teach them diligently to your sons and shall talk of them when you sit in your house and when you walk by the way and when you lie down and when you rise up. Deuteronomy 6:7

Each day Jesus was teaching at the temple, and each evening he went out to spend the night on the hill called the Mount of Olives, and all the people came early in the morning to hear him at the temple. Luke 21:38

FORGIVENESS: So Peter and the other disciple went forth, and they were going to the tomb. The two were running together and the other disciple ran ahead faster than Peter and came to the tomb first.

Simon Peter also came, following him, and entered the tomb.
