Appear: come in sight, show up, to become evident or manifest, to come into existence, enters the scene.

1. His appearance in our lives produces confidence.

Now, little children, abide in Him, so that when He appears, we may have confidence and not shrink. 1 John 2:28

Keep up your courage, for I believe God that it will turn out exactly as I have been told; Look!; I see four men loosed and walking about in the midst of the fire without harm, and the appearance of the fourth is like a Son of God." Acts 27:25; Daniel 3:25

The disciples had gathered together, but, fearful of the Jews, had locked all the doors in the house. Jesus entered, stood among them, and said, "Peace to you. The disciples, seeing the Master were exuberant. "Peace to you. Just as the Father sent me, I send you." John 20:19-21

But being full of the Holy Spirit, he gazed intently into heaven and saw the glory of God, and Jesus standing at the right hand of God; Acts 7:55

2. His appearance in our lives shows us endless possibilities.

We are children of God, and it has not appeared as yet what we will be. We know that when He appears, we will be like Him, we will see Him just as He is. 1 John 3:2

If we confess our sins, He is faithful and righteous to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness. I, even I, am the one who wipes out your transgressions for My own sake, And I will not remember your sins. 1 John 1:9; Isaiah 43:25
